- c. can only be handled by overhead lifting

Minimum Wharfage \$ 10.00

All cargo subject to Port of Houston Security Charge of \$ 0.19* per 2000 lbs. Container \$ 3.56 per container and vehicles \$ 1.02 per unit.

Free Time on containers as per Port of Houston Tariff – 3 business days

*NOTE 2: Port of Houston has increased the Port Security Fee for breakbulk effective 1 January 2017.
